- **Sunday morning elementary students will be dismissed by the Church. Children attending 11:00 Mass will enter with the Presentation of Gifts. Please let your student know where you will be sitting in Church.**
- **Please discuss with your student the appropriate behavior in class. Cooperation, respect for catechists and for their fellow students is expected. We ask that if they arrive early, they wait in the hall until their teacher is in the classroom; that there be no running or shouting in the halls; that they complete their homework when assigned; and that they respect the property of others.**
